**This Policy explains the rules and procedures regarding the use of pupil mobile phones at St Peter's Church of England Primary School**

### PUPILS

- Pupils in Year 4 and below are not allowed to bring mobile phones or smart watches\* to school.
- Pupils in Year 5 & 6 are not allowed to wear smart watches\* to school and are discouraged from bringing mobile phones to school unless an absolute necessity.
- If Year 5 & 6 pupils bring mobile phones to school, the phones must be given into the class Teacher at the beginning of the school day where they will be kept in a secure locked cupboard. They can be collected at the end of the school day.
- If Year 5 & 6 pupils are attending the After School Club, their phones will be passed to the Club Co-ordinator by the Class Teacher where they will be kept in a secure locked cupboard until the pupil is collected by a parent/guardian/carer.
- Should parents need to contact pupils this should be done following the usual school procedures via the school office.

- Where a pupil is found by a member of staff to have not handed their mobile phone in, the phone will be taken from the pupil, handed to a senior member of staff who will record the name of the child and attach to the phone. The mobile phone will be stored in the secure locked cupboard. Parents will be contacted before the end of the school day. The phone must be collected by the pupil at the end of the school day.
- If a pupil is found taking photographs or video footage with a mobile phone this will be regarded as a serious offence and disciplinary action will be taken according to the School's Behaviour Policy.
- If images of other pupils or teachers have been taken, the phone will not be returned to the pupil until the images have been removed by the pupil in the presence of a teacher. Parents will be contacted immediately.
- Parents are advised that St Peter's CoE Primary School accepts no liability for the loss or damage to mobile phones which are brought into the school or school grounds.

This policy supports the school's Health and Safety, Anti-bullying, Child Protection and Internet Acceptable Use policies. It will be monitored, reviewed and amended as required.

\*A smart watch is one with internet capability, or the ability to send and receive messages or take photos. Watches used as fitness trackers only – ie FitBits – are allowed.
